**Mr. Robert N. Caruso**  
**Director, Chairman - Compensation Committee and Member – Nominating / Governance Committee**

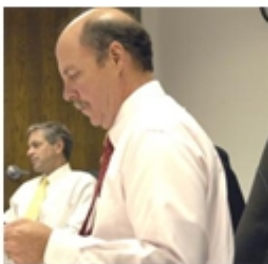
**Mr. Ronald B. Johnson**
